Change of Names Made to Bronco Student Center Rooms

A new constellation theme has been applied to the existing and new meeting rooms in the Bronco Student Center. The decision to change the meeting room names began in the 2001-2002 academic year and the constellation theme was approved by the ASI Senate and the University President during the 2002-2003 academic year.

The constellation theme will connect all Bronco Student Center conference and event meeting spaces making it easier for on and off-campus guests to identify meeting rooms in the 120,000 square foot facility.
