ASI To Hold Lost and Found Auction

The Games Room Etc. is holding its annual Lost and Found Auction on Thursday, April 24, 2003 from 12:00pm to 2:00pm in the University Park. Viewing of the items begins at 11:30am and is open to Cal Poly Pomona students, faculty and staff. Dave Johnson, Director of Judicial Affairs, will be Master of Ceremonies.

As the designated site for Cal Poly Pomona's Lost and Found, the Games Room Etc. regularly returns most of the lost items turned in. Items that go unclaimed for more than six months, however, are auctioned off. These include cell phones, calculators, books, clothes, and a variety of other items.

The annual Lost and Found Auction has been held for over a decade and all profits derived from the auction go to the Lost and Found Scholarship Fund. Funds are given to the Financial Aid Office to be distributed among current and incoming students in the form of various scholarships.

The Lost and Found is currently located in the Games Room Etc. which is on the lower level of the Bronco Student Center. If you have lost an item, you may report it by submitting an online report form on the Games Room Etc. section of the ASI general website at www.asi.csupomona.edu. You will be contacted if your item is found. If you have found an item that has been lost, it is suggested that you turn it in as soon as possible. Studies have shown that individuals stop searching for an item about a week after it is lost.
