Cal Poly Pomona's Music and Entertainment Industry Student Association (MEISA) received international honors at Annual Conference

On April 1, 2005, the Music and Entertainment Industry Educators Association (MEIEA) held their Annual International Conference in Miami, Florida where Cal Poly Pomona was named the 2005 Outstanding MEISA Chapter. The first recipient of this award, Cal Poly Pomona MEISA was recognized for their continuing efforts in making a positive impact on a local level through professional growth, performances, social activities, membership involvement and recruitment. Along with their recognition, the chapter received \$200 to apply to future programming and a personalized gold record to be displayed in the Music Department.

Attended by MEISA Chapter members and Associated Students, Inc.(ASI) representatives, the conference brought together university chapters from all over the nation to participate in panels, lectures, presentations, business sessions and social mixers. Students had an opportunity to learn about current issues in the music and entertainment industry as well as network with industry professionals. The National Battle of the Bands also took place during the annual conference where Cal Poly Pomona student group, The Obscured, took third place. The Obscured made it to the national level after winning the ASI Bronco Events and Activities Team (B.E.AT.) Bronco Underground Musicians and Performers (BUMP) 2005 Battle of the Bands in March.

In addition to the MEISA chapter's success at the conference, Cal Poly Pomona was also chosen as the site for the 2007 International MEIEA Conference. ASI B.E.A.T. and Cal Poly Pomona MEISA will host the event.
