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SDLI Workshops to Begin This Fall

The Student Development and Leadership Institute (SDLI), formerly the Adventures in Leadership Program, is a series of workshops that centralize the leadership experiences on the Cal Poly Pomona campus. SDLI will begin its first session October 7, 2003 and will conclude with a ceremony Spring 2004.

SDLI's mission is to provide education, development, and training that enhance student's personal leadership abilities for lifelong learning and success in a changing, multicultural world.

The workshops encourage students to think beyond the confines of their own experiences and use leadership and personal development as a continuous process for growth. SDLI also prepares students to become effective leaders on campus, in their communities, and future careers.

Participants are required to register online and attend two core workshops as well as four support workshops. The core workshops provide an orientation to the series and an introduction to leadership concepts, styles, and goals. The support workshops are designed to take the personal applications learned in the core workshops and begin implementing them in small group settings.

Registered participants that finish the requirements receive a certificate of completion. Two \$100 book grants will be awarded in an opportunity drawing for those that complete the requirements by May 3, 2004.
