Bronco Student Center Improving Center Court Dining Options

As part of a larger plan by the Cal Poly Pomona Foundation, Inc. to adjust to the changing dining needs of the campus community - students, faculty and staff returning from winter quarter recess will notice changes in Bronco Student Center food service venues and choices.

Kikka Sushi and Noodle Bar has relocated to the former Wok & Rome space in Center Court. Kikka will now offer an expanded menu in a larger location to better serve its growing number of customers.

Center Perk will be closed until further decisions are made regarding the use of this space. Starbucks brewed coffee and Tazo Tea, pastries, and self serve smoothies – formerly offered at Center Perk - will still be offered at Center Court but will be served instead at Pony Express.

In the meantime, temporary, upscale vending featuring healthy and convenient self-serve snack choices will be made available to the campus community in the former Center Perk and Kikka locations.

Cal Poly Pomona Foundation, Inc. and Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) are working together to evaluate dining choices and will be making additional exciting changes to Bronco Student Center dining in the near future.
