ASI Election 2003 Results

President Elect Jason Dyogi will lead the 2003-2004 Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) Executive Board with running mate and Vice-President Elect Jennifer Castañeda. The 2003 ASI Elections took place May 13 through May 15. Results were announced the evening of May 15. A record 2,258 ballots were cast in the three-day voting period.

Cal Poly Pomona students who voted were automatically entered into a drawing for a prize of free parking for one year at Cal Poly Pomona. Computer Science Major Badie Jaber is the winner of the drawing sponsored by the ASI Elections Committee.
