California State Student Association Appoints ASI Senator as New Financial Aid Officer

Kenneth Evans, ASI student senator for the College of Science, has been appointed as the new Financial Aid Officer for the California State Student Association (CSSA). In this prestigious position of CSSA Financial Aid officer, Evans will be responsible for representing the entire California State University (CSU) student body, serving as one of only two students who are voting members on the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC), the organization responsible for making all final decisions relating to educational financial aid for California college students. Evans will also be depended on to lend advice to CSSA on financial aid matters should they need assistance on making decisions. Evans states he is "looking forward to working with CSSA and CSAC this year and representing the students of the CSU system."

ASI representation in CSSA is fundamental for both the campus and the organization. CSSA serves as the official voice for over 400,000 students in the CSU System. The organization functions as the main channel of communication between the twenty three CSU campus student associations. It brings unity within the CSU system by addressing campus and statewide issues impacting individual campuses, student organizations and the CSU system. CSSA is a political organization that works in unison with the universities and the California State Legislature to represent students on all issues relating to higher education in California.

Established in 1963, Associated Students, Inc. is a recognized auxiliary organization of Cal Poly Pomona that is led, funded and mainly staffed by students. Guided by the core commitments to the promotion of student development and provision of quality facilities, programs and services, ASI provides for student representation at the campus and system-wide level and offers leadership development through student government, student-led programming, student employment and student involvement in a wide array of Bronco Student Center programs and services, including the Bronco Fitness Center, as well as the Children's Center. ASI fully supports the enrichment of student life by providing annual funding support for student clubs and organizations, diversity programs, athletic scholarships and academic support programs.
