The twenty-two minute encounter allows the viewer to experience special effects like water sprays, air blasts and rain all synchronized to on-screen action. The show is at SeaWorld's San Diego Mission Bay Theatre. Seats are equipped with specialized surround-sound speakers to enhance the sensory experience.
