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Bronco Student Center is OPEN

It's here. The new and improved Bronco Student Center, a service of Associated Students, Incorporated (ASI), made its debut as it opened its doors April 2, 2003. With the opening of its doors, the newly expanded facility will add many new services to its diverse cache that are sure to excite students, faculty, staff, and guests.

New additions include the Bronco Fitness Center, an 11,000 square foot space dedicated to health promotion and wellness. The comprehensive fitness center will be professionally and student staffed and will feature extensive machine and free weight equipment, as well as extensive cardiovascular equipment including bikes, treadmills, and elliptical and rowing machines.

The Bronco Fitness Center will also feature fitness, aerobic, and spin classes in its group exercise room where students have access to state-of-the-art equipment. Locker rooms, equipped with restrooms and showers, are also available making it convenient to workout before, between, and after classes. Memberships are now available to Cal Poly Pomona students for \$15.00 a month, and to faculty, staff, and alumnus for \$25.00 a month.

The 500-seat, mall-style food court is an exciting part of the opening of the Bronco Student Center. Currently open are Kikka Sushi and Noodle Bar and Round Table Pizza. New additions that are scheduled to open in May are Center Perk and Pony Express. Stuffed Sub, Strips & Chips, and Wok & Rome are scheduled for opening in June, July, and August respectively.

The new Multipurpose Room in the Bronco Student Center can be utilized for large meetings, conferences and other and gatherings. It features a stage complete with dressing rooms backstage, audio/visual equipment, and the capacity to hold 800 seats.

The Bronco Student Center also contains 10 additional meeting rooms for group study meetings, and on-campus club and organization meetings. The new outdoor study terrace and quiet spaces around the building will provide a place for individual study.

The Wellness Center, Student Health Services' satellite facility, will be moving from its existing location into the Bronco Student Center. The Wellness Center provides preventative health programs and services. Services at the Wellness Center will continue to be provided for free and no appointments are needed. The Wellness Center and Bronco Fitness Center will partner to enhance health, fitness and wellness opportunities for the campus community.

With the new building, comes additional wall space that will be dedicated to the Bronco Student Center Art Program. The Art Program is a partnership between the Art Department and ASI that will feature commissioned student art, community art shows, cultural exhibitions, and other art acquisitions.

The opening of the new and improved Bronco Student Center and the growing excitement will commence on April 29, 2003 with the Bronco Student Center Dedication and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony from 12:00pm to 1:00pm in the University Park.
