Uwaifo Obanor and Jesse Cerda are President Elect and Vice-President Elect, respectively, after the closest vote count in ASI history. Obanor currently serves as a 2001-02 senator-at-large. Cerda is finishing his term as the 2001-02 senator for College of Education and Integrative Studies.

ASI 2002 Elections took place April 30 through May 2. Thursday, May 2, the official vote tally was electronically and hand-counted. Each hand-count was confirmed twice before it was made official. The same Presidential and Vice-Presidential ticket won both the electronic and hand count. The total amount of votes cast was 1,202. There was one invalid ballot cast.
