Kikka's Sushi and Noodle Bar Opens in the University Union

A new dining concept has hit Cal Poly Pomona at the University Union. Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) and the Cal Poly Pomona Foundation have partnered to bring Kikka's Sushi and Noodle Bar.

Kikka's has opened in the former location of the Stuffed Sub on the first floor of the Union. Stuffed Sub has been relocated to the Campus Center Marketplace. Started in 1986 with locations including University of California at Irvine, Kikka's is Cal Poly Pomona Foundation's latest concept designed to increase the choices of on-campus dining.

Grab and go food has rapidly become a favorite among students, faculty and staff pressed for time. Kikka's will provide a wide variety of sushi, rolls, noodle soup, and salad. Selections range from simple to complex with vegetarian options available. The initial price list for sushi runs from \$2.90 for a Cucumber Roll to \$8.25 for the Rainbow Roll, with the majority of items falling at the median price point. Soups run around \$4.40 and all salads are under \$4.

With over 57 menu options featuring unique campus fare, Kikka's Sushi and Noodle Bar is the newest highlight to on-campus dining choices.
